Mr. Lauderbach is a partner in the Midland office of Warner Norcross & Judd LLP. He specializes in commercial litigation and bankruptcy matters, representing creditors in bankruptcy court proceedings, non-bankruptcy workouts, foreclosures and restructurings. Mr. Lauderbach was elected to the Midland County Circuit Court in 2006, and served in that capacity until March of 2013 when he stepped down to return to private practice. While serving in the judiciary, he was a member of the Executive Committee of the Michigan Judges Association and chaired its subcommittee on corrections policy. Mr. Lauderbach is an adjunct faculty member at the Michigan State University College of Law and is a Fellow of the Michigan State Bar Foundation.

Active in community and civic affairs, he is a member of the boards of directors of Midland Tomorrow and the Midland Area Chamber of Commerce, and is a member of the Advisory Board of the Alden B. Dow Museum of Science and Art. He was appointed by the Michigan Supreme Court to a three-year term on the Attorney Discipline Board, commencing October 1, 2015. He was appointed to a second three-year term in 2018. The Court also appointed him to a one-year term as Vice-Chairperson commencing October 1, 2018.
