Fr. Murray is deputy general counsel for the Catholic Diocese of Lansing and administrator of St. Martha Parish in Okemos. He is a graduate of the University of Michigan Law School. He also holds graduate degrees in Theology and Labor and Industrial Relations. His undergraduate degree is from Michigan State University. In the past, he has served as Chief Commissioner of the Michigan Supreme Court, Chair of the Michigan Attorney Grievance Commission, and Moderator of the Curia of the Catholic Diocese of Lansing. Fr. Murray was appointed by the Supreme Court to a three-year term on the Attorney Discipline Board, commencing October 1, 2013. He was re-appointed to a second three-year term in 2016. The Court also appointed him to a one-year terms as Vice-Chairperson commencing in October 1, 2016, and October 1, 2017.
