Suspension - 180 Days, Effective March 2, 2022

Respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a Stipulation for Consent Order of Discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. Pursuant to the parties' stipulation, the panel found that respondent committed professional misconduct when he was convicted in 2020 and 2021 for misdemeanor disorderly person (window peeping) in violation of MCL 750.167(1)(c), and his 2021 criminal conviction for misdemeanor trespassing in violation of MCR 750.552, reduced from window peeping (*People v Donovan Rashaad Johnson*, Case 20BT00820, 48th District Court; *People v Donovan Rashaad Johnson*, Case 20SO0149A, 46th District Court; *People v Donovan Rashaad Johnson*, Case 20-004728, 52-3rd District Court.)

Based on respondent's admissions and the stipulation of the parties, the panel found that respondent engaged in conduct that violated a criminal law of a state or of the United States, an ordinance, or tribal law pursuant to MCR 2.615, in violation of MCR 9.104(5).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 180 days with conditions relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$820.91.
